Programs that utilize the therapeutic properties of exercise, heat, cold, electricity, ultraviolet, water and massage to help restore function, improve mobility, relieve pain, and prevent or limit permanent physical disabilities of patients suffering from injuries or disease.

Programs that prepare expectant mothers for childbirth and provide health care services for mothers and infants during pregnancy and following birth.

## **F01 Mental Health, Substance Abuse Programs, General/other**

Programs that provide preventive, diagnostic and treatment services as well as transitional support for people who have a physical and/or psychological dependency on tobacco, alcohol and/or other drugs or who suffer from acute or chronic mental or emotional disturbances or are having problems coping with daily living.

### **F02 Crisis Intervention**

Programs that provide immediate assistance for people who are in acute emotional distress; who are or perceive themselves to be in life-threatening situations; who are a danger to themselves or to others; or who are hysterical, frightened or otherwise unable to cope with a problem that requires immediate action.

#### **F02.03 Substance Abuse Crisis Intervention**

Programs that provide in-person immediate response services or telephone contact with trained individuals for people who are in life-threatening situations due to a drug overdose or acute intoxication.

#### **F03 Mental Disorders**

Programs that support the prevention, treatment and cure of psychiatric illness or diseases manifested by breakdowns in the adaptational process expressed primarily as abnormalities of thought, feeling, and behavior producing either distress or impairment of function.

Programs that support the prevention, treatment and cure of anxiety disorders -- disorders in which anxiety (persistent feelings of apprehension, tension, or uneasiness) is the predominant disturbance.

#### **F03.04 Childhood Mental Health Disorders**

Programs that support the prevention, treatment and cure of psychiatric disorders usually first diagnosed in infancy, childhood, or adolescence. These disorders can also be first diagnosed during other life stages.

#### **F03.05 Cognitive Disorders**

Programs that support the prevention, treatment and cure of cognitive disorders including amnesia, delirium & dementia. These may be the result of substance use, trauma, or other causes.

#### **F03.07 Eating Disorders**

There are two main types of eating disorders, Anorexia Nervosa and Bulimia Nervosa. Anorexia Nervosa is characterized by a refusal eat that leads to a below normal body weight. Bulimia Nervosa is characterized by repeated binge eating followed by self-inducing vomiting, misusing laxatives, fasting, or excessive exercise.

#### **F03.09 Impulse-Control Disorders**

#### **F03.11 Personality Disorders**

Personality disorders are enduring patterns of inner experience and behavior that deviates markedly from the expectations of the individual's culture, is pervasive and inflexible, has an onset in adolescence or early adulthood, is stable over time, and leads to distress or impairment.

Programs that support the prevention, treatment and cure of somatoform disorders, disorders having the presence of physical symptoms that suggest a general medical condition but that are not fully explained by a general medical condition, by the direct effects of a substance, or by another mental disorder. The symptoms must cause clinically significant distress or impairment in social, occupational, or other areas of functioning. In contrast to FACTITIOUS DISORDERS, the physical symptoms are not under voluntary control.

### **F03.17 Schizophrenia & Other Psychotic Disorders**

Programs that support the prevention, treatment and cure of schizophrenia & other psychotic disorders, marked disorders of thought (delusions, hallucinations, or other thought disorder accompanied by disordered affect or behavior), and deterioration from a previous level of functioning.

### **F03.18 Sexual & Gender Identity Disorders**

### **F03.19 Sleep Disorders**

Programs that support the prevention, treatment and cure of sleep disorders, disorders characterized by disturbances of usual sleep patterns or behaviors. Sleep disorders may be divided into three major categories: Dyssomnias (i.e. disorders characterized by insomnia or hypersomnia), Parasomnias (abnormal sleep behaviors), and sleep disorders secondary to medical or psychiatric disorders.

### **F04.02 Inpatient Mental Health Treatment**

Programs that provide diagnostic and inpatient treatment services for individuals who have acute or chronic mental or emotional disturbances, who require hospitalization, and who might be a threat to themselves, to their families or to others if left in the community or placed in a less restrictive treatment setting.

### **F04.03 Outpatient Mental Health Treatment**

Programs that provide walk-in, walk-out diagnostic and treatment services for individuals who have acute or chronic mental or emotional disturbances but do not need twenty-four hour care; and/or counseling services for individuals, couples, families or extended personal groups who may be experiencing difficulty resolving personal or interpersonal conflicts or making personal adjustments to stressful life conflicts.

### **F04.04 Residential Mental Health Treatment**

Community-based residential programs that provide long or short-term treatment in the context of a twenty-four hour, supervised environment for people who have mental health problems.

## **F05 Psychiatric Case Management**

Programs that develop case plans for the evaluation, treatment and/or care of individuals who have mental, emotional or social problems and need assistance in arranging or planning for services and coordinate the delivery of needed services.

## **F06 Specialized Counseling**

Programs that provide emotional support, problem-solving assistance, information and guidance through a variety of modalities for individuals who are having difficulty in coping with a traumatic experience or a personal relationship or in making the adjustments that are required by their particular stage in life.

### **F06.02 Family Violence Counseling**

Programs that provide emotional support, information and guidance for people who are experiencing physical and/or emotional abuse in the context of an intimate relationship.

#### **F06.02.02 Child Abuse Counseling**

Programs that provide a wide variety of therapeutic interventions for individuals and/or families who are coping with the trauma arising from child abuse.

#### **F06.02.03 Spouse Abuse Counseling**

Programs that provide individual, conjoint, family or group treatment for individuals who are being physically, sexually and/or emotionally abused by their mates.

### **F06.03 Grief Counseling**

Programs that provide emotional support, problem-solving assistance, information and guidance for people who have recently lost a loved one.

Bereavement Counseling

### **F06.04 Marriage Counseling**

Programs that provide emotional support, problem-solving assistance, information and guidance for one or both married or cohabitating partners who are having problems with their relationship.

### **F06.05 Pastoral Counseling**

Programs that provide therapeutic interventions for people in the context of their religious beliefs.

Programs that offer individual therapeutic sessions which are facilitated or guided by an individual who is the same age as the client (an age-peer) or who has experienced and resolved the same type of problem as the client.

Programs that utilize psychological or physical forms of treatment to improve the adjustment of individuals who have mental, emotional or social problems.

### **F07.02 Animal-Assisted Therapy**

Programs that help emotionally disturbed or isolated individuals improve their personal and social functioning by giving them an opportunity to care for and/or relate to a pet.

### **F07.03 Creative Arts Therapy**

Programs that enable individuals with mental, emotional or social problems to communicate their emotions and conflicts through fine arts, dance, music, and/or other art forms.

**F08 Substance Abuse**

Programs that provide preventive, diagnostic and inpatient, outpatient and residential treatment services as well as transitional support for people who have a physical and/or psychological dependency on tobacco, alcohol and/or other drugs.

Programs that evaluate individuals who are in need of substance abuse services and refer them to the inpatient, outpatient or residential treatment services they require.

**F08.03 Detoxification**

Programs that provide alcohol and other drug-free congregate living arrangements, relapse prevention programs and other services which facilitate the return to the community of individuals who are recovering from problems relating to substance abuse, who may be leaving an inpatient or residential treatment program and who need ongoing support to sustain an abstinent lifestyle.

## **F08.10 Substance Abuse Prevention**

## **G02 Diseases & Disorders**

Programs, supported primarily by voluntary contributions from the public at large, that are active in the prevention, treatment and cure of diseases and disorders.

### **G02.02 Allergy & Immunological Diseases**

Programs that support the prevention, treatment and cure of diseases and conditions that affect the immune system.

Programs that support the prevention, treatment and cure of cerebral palsy, a central nervous system impairment that is characterized by an inability to fully control motor function.

Programs that support the prevention, treatment and cure of cystic fibrosis, an inherited disease that affects the pancreas, respiratory system, and sweat glands.

#### **G02.03.04 Down Syndrome**

Programs that support the prevention, treatment and cure of Down Syndrome, an inherited condition that results in mental retardation.

## **G02.04 Cancer**

Programs that support the prevention, treatment and cure of neoplasms, abnormal formations of tissue, such as a tumor or growth, which serve no useful function, but grow at the expense of the healthy organism.

Programs involved in the systematic study of the prevention, diagnosis and treatment of diseases and conditions caused by the tubercle bacillus.

Programs involved in the systematic study of the prevention, diagnosis and treatment of diseases of the musculoskeletal system.

#### **H02.14.04 Lupus Research**

Programs involved in the systematic study of the prevention, diagnosis and treatment of lupus. In its cutaneous form, it is a chronic disease which causes skin lesions on the face, neck and upper extremities. In its systemic form, it is a chronic inflammatory disease of the connective tissue which affects the skin, joints, kidneys, nervous system and mucous membranes.

#### **H02.14.05 Muscular Dystrophy Research**

Programs involved in the systematic study of the prevention, diagnosis and treatment of muscular dystrophy, an inherited disorder characterized by progressive degeneration of skeletal muscles.

#### **H02.14.06 Osteoporosis Research**

Programs involved in the systematic study of the prevention, diagnosis and treatment of osteoporosis, a disease characterized by low bone mass and deterioration of bone tissue.

#### **H02.15 Nervous System Diseases Research**

Programs involved in the systematic study of the prevention, diagnosis and treatment of diseases of the nervous system.

Programs involved in the systematic study of the prevention, diagnosis and treatment of amyotrophic lateral sclerosis, a syndrome marked by muscular weakness and atrophy with spasticity and hyperreflexia due to degeneration of the motor neurons of the spinal cord, medulla, and cortex.

#### **H02.15.04      Epilepsy Research**

Programs involved in the systematic study of the prevention, diagnosis and treatment of epilepsy, a recurrent paroxysmal disorder of cerebral function marked by sudden, brief interruptions in or complete loss of consciousness, motor activity and/or sensory phenomena.

#### **H02.15.05      Multiple Sclerosis Research**

Programs involved in the systematic study of the prevention, diagnosis and treatment of multiple sclerosis, a chronic, slowly progressive disease of the central nervous system in which the myelin sheath which covers the nerves hardens resulting in difficulties with muscle control, involuntary movements of the eyeballs, speech problems and tremor.

Programs involved in the systematic study of the branch of medicine associated with the aging process.

### **H03.06 Medical Genetics Research**

Programs involved in the systematic study of the field of human genetics which entails the reliable prediction of certain human disorders as a function of the lineage and/or genetic makeup of any two parents or potential parents.

Programs involved in the systematic study of the branch of medicine based on the theory that the normal body is a vital mechanical organism whose structural and functional states are of equal importance and is capable of making its own remedies against infections and toxic conditions when there are favorable environmental circumstances and adequate nutrition.

### **I02 Crime Control & Prevention**

Programs that discourage preventable crime, obtain information from the public about suspected criminal activity, investigate alleged crimes, provide support for witnesses to and victims of crimes and reduce targeted types of crime.
